## CHAPTER 131.

*An act to amend section one (1) of chapter one hundred and sixty-three (163) of the general laws of A. D. eighteen hundred and ninety-three (1893), entitled "An act to authorize town supervisors to issue the bonds or orders of their respective towns, for the purpose of refunding or paying outstanding bonds of said towns, and regulating the issue and providing for the payment thereof."*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and sixty-three (163) of the general laws of the state of Minnesota for the year A. D. eighteen hundred and ninety-three (1893), be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows;

Sec. one (1). The board of supervisors of any organized township of this state, or township that may be hereafter organized, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds or orders of such town, with interest coupons attached, whenever authorized by a majority of the legal voters of said town, as hereinafter provided, for the purpose of refunding, or raising money with which to pay any outstanding bonds or existing indebtedness of such town, which shall have become due and payable, or about to become due and payable before the moneys necessary for the payment of the same have been raised by taxation.
