## CHAPTER 303.

l'ownsite trusts. An act to vest in the district courts all trusts relating to townsites heretofore vested in any judge of said court.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Vested in district court, SECTION 1. That wherever by virtue of any statute the trust under the townsite act of congress of May 23rd, 1844, may have been conferred upon or vested in any judge of the district court of this state, the same shall henceforth be conferred upon and vested in such district court, to be exercised by any of the judges of said court within their proper districts.

Condraing acts SEC. 2. That all acts of or before any of the judges of said court heretofore done in the course of proceedings for the execution of such trust under the law of congress aforesaid, shall be deemed to be of the same effect and validity as though such trust had been theretofore in terms legally conferred upon and vested in said courts to be exercised by any of the judges thereof.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 304.

Jurors' fees.

95 C 304 62-M - 283 64-NW 813 An act to regulate the payment of grand and petit jurors' fees and mileage in the district courts of the State of Minnesota and to make the same equal and uniform in all the counties throughout the state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

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SECTION 1. Each grand and petit juror shall be entitled to two dollars for each day's attendance upon any district court in any county within this state and ten cents for each mile traveled in going to and returning from the said court; the distance to be computed by
