## CHAPTER 307.

H. F. No. 814.

An act to abolish the municipal court of the city of Municipal Duluth, known and designated as municipal court numher two (2) of said city, the same being the municipal court organized and existing in what was formerly the village of West Duluth under sub-chapter eleven (11) of chapter one hundred and forty-six (146) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891), and continued and made a municipal court of the city of Duluth by section seven (7) of an act entitled "An act providing for the extension of the limits of the city of Duluth by the annexation of the village of West Duluth, the village of Lakeside and other adjacent territory of said city of Duluth," being chapter fifty-six (56) of the special laws of eighteen hundred and ninetyone (1891), and also continued and made a municipal court of the city of Duluth by section five (5) of chapter one hundred and ninety (190) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three (1893).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the municipal court of the city of Abolishing Duluth known and designated as municipal court court No 2 of number two (2) of said city, the same being the muni- Duluth, cipal court organized and existing in what was formerly the village of West Duluth under sub-chapter eleven (11) of chapter one hundred and forty-six (146) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891), and continued and made a municipal court of the city of Duluth by section seven (7) of an act entitled "An act providing for the extension of the limits of the city of Duluth by the annexation of the village of West Duluth, the village of Lakeside and other adjacent territory to said city of Duluth," being chapter fifty-six (56) of the special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891), and also continued and made a municipal court of the city of Duluth by section five (5) of chapter one hundred and ninety (190) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three (1893), be and the same is hereby abolished.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the eighteenth (18) day of May A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (1895).
