CHAPTER 310.

H. F. No. 24

An act relating to the compilation of the general laws of Minnesota by Henry B. Wenzel and others and to declare such compilation competent evidence of the law in all courts of this state.

Wenzel statutes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The general laws of the state of Minnesota, in force December thirty-first (31st), one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four (1894), as compiled by Henry B. Wenzel and others and entitled The general statutes of the state of Minnesota, are hereby declared competent evidence of the several acts and resolutions therein contained in all courts of this state without further proof or authentication, and shall be known and cited as "General Statutes, 1894."

Recognized and authenticated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 311.

H. F. No. 816.

An act relating to the salary of the supreme court reporter.

Supreme court reporter.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the supreme court reporter, from and after January first (1st), A. D. eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895), shall be the sum of two thousand (\$2,000) dollars per annum.

Salary.

SEC. 2. That said sum of two thousand (\$2,000) dollars shall be appropriated annually for the payment of said salary.

Appropriation.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
