Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section thirteen (13) of title two (2) of chapter sixty-five (65) of the general statutes of Minnesota, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-

eight, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 13. In all cases not otherwise provided for, the first process is by summons, commanding the officer to able. summon the defendant to appear before such justice at a time and place expressed in such summons, not less than six nor more than twenty days from the date thereof, to answer to the plaintiffin a civil action, which summons shall be served at least six days before the time of appearance therein mentioned, by reading the same to the defendant and delivering a copy thereof to him, if such defendant can be found, and if not found, by leaving a copy thereof at his or her last usual place of abode with a person of suitable age and discretion then residing therein.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.
