

CHAPTER 356.

H. F. No. 879.

An act to appropriate money for additional clerk hire in the office of the secretary of state.

Secretary of state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of four hundred (400) dollars, for the fiscal year A. D. eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895), and annually thereafter, as additional clerk hire in the office of secretary of state.

Clerk hire—appropriation.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 357.

H. F. No. 877

An act to appropriate money for the purchase of machinery and materials to be used for certain purposes in the state penitentiary, said appropriation being contingent upon the adoption of the state account system, or for the purchase of the machinery under the "piece price" system.

State penitentiary.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifty thousand (50,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of purchasing machinery and materials for the employment of convicts confined in the state prison at Stillwater.

Appropriation for machinery, &c.

Provided, however, that no part of the said appropriation shall be available for the purposes named in this section unless, the board of managers of the said prison adopt what is known and denominated as the state account or piece price system.

SEC. 2. The state auditor is hereby authorized to draw his warrants for such amounts and in favor of such persons as shall be designated by the board of managers of said prison.

How paid.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
