An act to appropriate money for the payment of a State Univerdeficiency in the current expenses of the University of Minnesota for the years eighteen hundred ninety-three (1893) eighteen hundred ninety-four (1894) and eighteen hundred ninety-five (1895).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of sixty thousand dollars Appropriation. or so much thereof as is necessary is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not other-
