

CHAPTER 391.

S. F. No. 349.

An act to repeal chapter CLVIII of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, in relation to the election of county commissioners, in the county of Anoka.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter CLVIII of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred seventy-six be and the same is hereby repealed. Chap. 158 S. L.
1876.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 392.

An act to repeal chapter four hundred eighty-nine (489) of special laws of the state of Minnesota, for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891). Approved February twenty-sixth (26th), 1891. Entitled "An act to regulate the catching of fish in any of the lakes and streams of Chisago county and to prohibit shipping out of said county for the purpose of sale any fish caught in lakes or streams in said county, and to repeal all laws inconsistent therewith." H. F. No. 625.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter four hundred eighty-nine (489) of the special laws of the state of Minnesota for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891) being "An act to regulate the catching of fish in any of the lakes and streams of Chisago county and to prohibit shipping out of said county for the purpose of sale any fish caught in lakes or streams in said county and to repeal all laws inconsistent therewith," be and the same is hereby repealed. Chap. 489 S. L.
1891.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
