CHAPTER 407.

Election contest.

An act for an appropriation to reimburse George Gerlach for his expenses incurred in the contest of his election as a member of the legislature of the state of Minnesota for the present term.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

George Gerlach

SECTION 1. That the sum of seventy-five (75) dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated to be paid to George Gerlach, a member of the present house of representatives of the legislature of the state of Minnesota to reimburse him for his expenses incurred in the contest for his seat in said house instituted by Walter Nelson. That a warrant in favor of said George Gerlach for that sum be drawn by the proper officers of the state of Minnesota and delivered to him for payment.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 408.

An act providing for the hearing, trial, determination, and adjustment of an alleged claim of Eugene Guilbault.

Eugene Guilbault vs. Alfred McCarger and Wm. B. Barnard.

Whereas, Eugene Guilbault represents that he is the owner of a certain claim against Alfred McCarger and Wm. B. Barnard, which said claim consists of a judgment rendered and entered in the district court for the county of Rice, on the third day of June, eighteen hundred and sixty-one, in favor of the said Eugene Guilbault and against the said Alfred McCarger and Wm. B. Barnard for the sum of eight hundred and ninety-nine dollars and twenty-one cents, and that on the fourth day of December eighteen hundred and eighty-one, the papers necessary and proper to bring said claim before the commission established by an act entitled "An act for the adjustment of certain alleged claims against the state," approved November fourth, eighteen hundred and eighty-one; were duly made out and mailed to the state auditor, and that said commission declined to consider said claim solely on the ground that the state auditor did not receive said papers within the time prescribed by said act, and that
