An act to amend section twenty (20) of chapter thirty-six (36) of the general statutes A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) as amended by section one (1) of chapter fifty-seven (57) general laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885) relating to school meetings in common school districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty (20) of chapter thirty-six (36) general statutes A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) as the same is amended by section one (1) of chapter fifty-seven (57) of the general laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885) be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "meeting" in the sixth line thereof, the following words, to-wit:

"And the polls shall remain open for one hour."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

An act to amend section sixteen (16) of chapter eleven (11) of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878) as amended by section one (1) of chapter one hundred and twenty-six (126) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885) as amended by chapter two (2) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885), relating to assessments and collection of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That subdivision five (5) of section sixteen (16) of chapter eleven (11) of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878) as amended by section one (1) of chapter one hundred and twenty-six (126) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885) as amended by chapter two (2) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
