The bonded indebtedness of the state was reduced during the fiscal year of 1895 \$300,000, to wit:

Nov. 21, 1894, Revenue Bond No. 1, held by permanent university fund, \$50,000, paid out of redemption fund; March 25, 1895, Revenue Bonds Nos. 2, 3 and 4, No. 2 Internal Improvement Land Fund, held by permanent school fund, \$250,000, was paid out of general revenue fund, in conformity with the law passed by the legislature, Senate File No. 112, as recommended by my predecessor, Jos. Kobleter, in his report of fiscal year ending July 31, 1894.

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I find that high grade bonds are very scarce, that the investment demand is large and the supply comparatively small.

I investigated the securities held by our state in permanent school and university funds, the investments having been made by my predecessors, and feel safe in saying that our holdings are safe and, on the prices paid, will show a very handsome gain on the investment.

There will be submitted to the people of our state, at the next general election, an amendment to the constitution enlarging the scope of investments of the permanent school and university funds (permitting investments to be made in city, town and village bonds), which, if it becomes a law, will provide for the permanent investment of all of our funds.

I heartily indorse the passage of the amendment to the constitution and hope it will become a law.
