Joint resolution in relation to mineral lands and mineral contracts on state lands. Mineral lands.

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

That the commissioner of the state land office is hereby directed to suspend the further issue of mineral leases and contracts on state lands until further action relative to such leases and contracts is taken by the present legislature. Issue of mineral leases and contracts suspended.

JOINT MEMORIAL.

[H. F. NO. 150.]

A joint memorial to the senate and house of representatives of the state of Minnesota recommending the election of United States Senators by a popular vote. U. S. Senator.

Whereas, it is the sentiment of the people of the state of Minnesota that United States senators be elected by popular vote; therefore,

Resolved, by the house of representatives, the senate concurring, that our senators and representatives in congress be instructed and requested to use their influence in securing such an amendment to the constitution of the United States as will confer upon the electors of the several states the right to choose their senators at general elections. Request for election by popular vote.

Resolved, further, that the secretary of state be and he is hereby requested to forward one copy of this memorial to each of our senators and representatives in congress at as early a day as may be convenient.
