organized township or school district, and deliver up all orders or other evidence of indebtedness of such municipal corporation or other body politic, taking triplicate receipts therefor, one of which shall be filed in the office of the county auditor, and for all moneys at any time paid over to any town, city or school district treasurer, one of which receipts he shall transmit by mail on the day received by him to the clerk or recorder of the town, city or school district to which treasurer the money is paid, which receipt shall be filed and safely kept by such clerk or recorder in his office.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this

act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred and \$325 to twenty-five (325) dollars be and hereby is appropriated man. out of the general revenue fund of the state of Minnesota to reimburse Mathias Lellman for expenses incurred by him in a contest for a seat in the house of representatives during the thirtieth (30th) session of the legislature of said state for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven (1897).

SEC. 2. That the sum of three hundred and twenty- \$325 to G. L. five (325) dollars be and hereby is appropriated out of the general revenue fund of the state of Minnesota to reimburse George L. Dingman for expenses incurred by him in a contest for a seat in the house of representatives during the thirtieth (30th) session of the legislature of said state during the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven (1897).
