

CHAPTER 243.

S. F. No 581.

An act to amend chapter two hundred and fifty-four (254) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889) relating to the state prison.

Relating to state prison.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter two hundred and fifty-four (254) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889) be amended as follows: Amendment.

SEC. 2. That section twenty-seven (27) of said act shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 27. The warden shall have authority under such rules as the board of managers may prescribe, to furnish all convicts released from prison with one good serviceable suit of clothing at the expense of the state, including a suit of underclothing. He shall also furnish to convicts released between the first (1st) day of October and the thirty-first (31st) day of March, a good serviceable overcoat, and to pay to each prisoner the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25) in money to be drawn from the current expense fund. Said money shall be paid to the prisoner upon his discharge from prison. Warden to provide money and clothing to released prisoners.

SEC. 3. Section forty-two (42) of said act is hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after August first (1st), eighteen hundred and ninety-seven (1897).

CHAPTER 244.

An act to amend chapter two hundred and seventy-four (274) of the general laws of the state of Minnesota for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895), relating to the destruction of the Russian thistle and granting power to the county commissioners to rebate taxes thereunder.

Russian thistle and rebate of taxes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section four (4) be and the same is hereby amended by adding to the end of said section the following words: Amendment.
