CHAPTER 277.

Repeal of act perpetuating section and quarter corners of the U. S. survey.

An act to repeal an act entitled "An act to permanently establish and perpetuate the section and quarter-section corners of the United States government survey."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter two hundred and forty-nine (249) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (1895), be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 278.

Sanitary regulation of bakeries, confectionery and other manufactories of food products.

An act to amend chapter one hundred and ninety-nine (199) of the general laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five (1895), an act to provide for the sanitary regulation of bakeries and other establishments for the manufacture of bread and other food products.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred ninety-nine (199) of the general laws of eighteen hundred ninety-five (1895) be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 1. All buildings occupied for bakeries and confectionery establishments shall be well drained, and all plumbing therein shall be constructed in accordance with well-established sanitary principles and of good workmanship, and the rooms thereof used for the manufacture or sale of bread and other food products shall be
