Court terms,
3d dist.

An act fixing the time for holding the general terms of the district court in Olmsted county and in Wabasha county, in the Third judicial district, and to amend section 4913 of the general statutes of Minnesota for the year 1894, being section 1, chapter 60 of the general laws of 1879.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The general terms of the district court in and for the county of Olmsted, in the Third judicial district, shall be held on the third Monday of June, and the second Monday in December of each year.

SEC. 2. The general terms of the district court in and for the county of Wabasha, in the Third judicial district, shall be held on the fourth Monday of May, and the second Monday of November, in each year.

SEC. 3. Inconsistent acts in former laws are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. All writs, process, continuances, bonds, recognizances, appeals, notices and proceedings had, issued or returnable to the terms of court, as heretofore established by former statute, shall be deemed and construed as made, taken and returnable to the terms of court as fixed by this act.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
