CHAPTER 4.

An act to amend section 205 of title 7 of chapter 8, Sheriffs and coroners. general statutes of the State of Minnesota, 1878, being section 795, general statutes, 1894, relating to sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section 205 of title 7 of chapter 8, of the general statutes of the state of Minnesota, 1878, being sec. 795, gen. stat's 1894, be and it is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 205. No sheriff, deputy sheriff or coroner shall Not to pracappear or practice as an attorney, solicitor or counselor torneys. in any court, nor draw or fill up any process, pleading or proceeding, for any party in any action, nor with intent to be employed in the collection of any demand, or the service of any process, advise or counsel any person to commence any action or proceeding, nor shall any sheriff or deputy sheriff be eligible to any other lucrative civil office, except town or city marshal; and either of said officers, for a violation of any of the provisions of this section shall forfeit a sum not exceeding fifty dollars, to be recovered by the county in a civil action."

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
