SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 44.

H. F. No. 275.

An act authorizing and empowering deputy county auditors to administer oaths in their respective counties and to certify the same under the seal of the county auditor.

Deputy auditors may administer oaths.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That in all counties of this state, the deputy county auditors, duly appointed and qualified, are by this act authorized and empowered to administer oaths in their respective counties and to certify the same under the seal of the county auditor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 45.

H. F. No. 145.

An act to repeal chapter two hundred and ninety-eight (298) of the general laws of Minnesota of eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895), entitled "An act providing for the enlargement of organized counties by attaching thereto and incorporating therein territory from an adjoining unorganized county or counties."

Repeals act for enlarging counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter two hundred and ninety-eight (298) of the general laws of Minnesota of eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895), entitled "An act providing for the enlargement of organized counties by attaching thereto and incorporating therein territory from an adjoining unorganized county or counties," be and the same is hereby repealed.
