

SEC. 2. That the authority and power conferred hereby upon such relief associations is in addition and supplemental to the power and authority heretofore conferred thereon to expend their moneys for the support and relief of sick, injured and disabled firemen, their widows and orphans.

Additional authority to that heretofore granted.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 56.

S. F. No. 44.

*An act to appropriate the sum of three thousand five hundred (\$3,500) dollars, for the purpose of purchasing additional land for the state public school of Owatonna.*

Appropriation for Owatonna public school.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of purchasing additional land for the state public school at Owatonna.

Appropriation.

SEC. 2. Said money so appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of the said state public school.

How expended.

SEC. 3. The state auditor is hereby authorized to draw his warrants for said sum, or so much thereof as shall be expended for said purpose, in favor of such persons as shall be designated by the said board of trustees of said public school.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
