An act authorizing and empowering cities in this state having more than 50,000 inhabitants to contract to operate for the purchase of electric power with which to operate works. their public water works.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Any city in this state having more than Cities of over 50,000 inhabitants, is hereby authorized and empowitants. ered, from time to time, to contract with any person, partnership, or corporation for the purchase of electric power, with which to operate the whole or any part of its public water works. Any such contract may be made for a term of years, not exceeding ten years.

Sec. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with

this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

An act to amend chapter one hundred and seventy Disnojution (170) of the general laws of Minnesota for eighteen of independent school hundred and eighty-five (1885), relating to the dissolu-districts. tion of independent school districts.

Chapter one hundred and seventy (170) Amendment. of the general laws of Minnesota for eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885), being an act to empower independent school districts organized under chapter thirtysix (36), general statutes one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), to dissolve the organization by a two-thirds (2-3) vote of the qualified electors of the same, be and the same hereby is amended by adding three (3) sections thereto so that when said chapter is so amended it shall read as follows:
