CHAPTER 1.

S. F. No. 1.

An act to appropriate money for the expenses of the present Appropriation. session of the legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand (150,000) dollars or so much thereof as may be 8150,000 apnecessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of the per diem, mileage and other expenses of the members and officers of the legislature during the present session thereof.

SEC 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
