W. F. Henremsy.

Appropriailon to reimburao him for expense of contest.

An act to appropriate moncy to reimburse W. B. ILennessy for his expenses incurred in the contest of his election as a member of the legislature of the State of Mimesota for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine (1899).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of two hundred and twentyfive (225) dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to be paid to W. B. Hennessy, a member of the present house of representatives of the legislature of the State of Minnesota to reimburse him for his expenses incurred in the contest for his seat in said house, instituted against him by one J. F. George. That a warrant payable to said W. B. Hennessy or to his order for said sum be drawn by the proper officer of the State of Minnesota and delivered to him or to his order for payment.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 62.

Officers of corporations.

Ofticers authorised to take acknowlodgments. May take when corporetion is interested.

An act authorizing officers, directors and stockholder:s of corporations to administer oaths and take acknowledgments of instruments wherein such corporation is interested.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Ninnesota:
Section 1. Any person anthorized to take acknowledgments or administer oaths, who is at the same time an officer, director or stockholder of a corporation, is hereby authorized to take acknowledgments of instruments wherein such corporation is interested, and to administer oaths to any other oflicer, director or stockholder of such corporation, as such, as fully and effectually as if he were not an officer, director or stockholder of such corpontion.

Sic. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
