CHAPTER 279.

Amendment,
Commence-
ment of
actions.

An act to amend section five thousand one hundred and thirty-five (5,135) of the General Statutes of eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), as amended by chapter one hundred and twenty-three (123) of the Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine (1899), relating to the time of the commencement of actions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section five thousand one hundred and thirty-five (5,135) of the General Statutes of eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894) as amended by chapter one hundred and twenty-three (123) of the laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine (1899), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 5135. An action upon a judgment or decree of a court of the United States or of any state or territory of the United States shall be commenced within ten (10) years.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 280.

Amendment,
lard and
lard com-
pounds.

An act to amend chapter twelve (12) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891), entitled "An act in relation to the manufacture and sale of lard and of lard compounds and substitutes, and of food prepared therefrom, to prevent fraud and to preserve the public health."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter twelve (12) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891), entitled "An act in relation to the manufacture and sale of lard and of lard compounds and substitutes, and of food prepared therefrom, to prevent fraud and to preserve the public health," shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. No person shall, within this state, manufacture for sale, have in his possession with intent to sell, offer, or expose for sale, or sell, as lard, any substance not the legitimate and exclusive product of the fat of the hog.
