

CHAPTER 305.

S. F. No. 107.

An act to amend section seven thousand five hundred and ninety-three of chapter one hundred and twenty-three of the General Statutes of the State of Minnesota of 1894, relating to deeds by sheriffs on sales made by predecessor.

Amendment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section 7593 of chapter 123 of the General Statutes of the State of Minnesota of 1894 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sheriff may execute deed of sale by former sheriff.

Sec. 7593. When any judicial sale of real property has heretofore been made, or may hereafter be made, by any sheriff whose term of office has expired, or by any sheriff whose office has for any reason been declared vacant, without a deed to complete such sale having been executed as required by law, such deed may be executed by the sheriff of the county in which such real property is situate, with the same force and effect as though executed by the sheriff making such sale.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts, whether the same be special or general acts, that are inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 306.

H. F. No. 32.

An act to amend section four (4), chapter one hundred and fifty (150) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), being section eight thousand four hundred and forty-five (8445), of the General Statutes of eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), relating to the burial by the state of honorably discharged soldiers or marines.

Amendment. Burial of soldiers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section four (4), chapter one hundred and fifty (150) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887) is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500) an-
