

CHAPTER 327.

H. F. No. 357.

An act to amend chapter two hundred and twenty-one (221) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven (1897) entitled: "An act for the preservation, propagation, protection, taking, use and transportation of game and fish."

Game and fish.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Amend section twenty-two (22) to read as follows:

No person shall catch, take, kill, have in possession or under control for any purpose whatever, any of the fish hereinafter mentioned within the periods herein limited, to-wit:

Any variety of trout, between the first day of September and the fifteenth (15th) day of April following, nor any black, gray, or Oswego bass between the first day of March and the first (1st) day of June following.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 328.

H. F. No. 421.

An act to provide compensation for clerks of the district court in certain cases.

Clerk of district court. Compensation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. In all counties containing a population of twenty-eight thousand (28,000) inhabitants and over, where the salary of the clerk of the district court is arbitrarily fixed at eight hundred (800) dollars or less, by special law, and where such clerk is required by such special law to pay over to the county all fees collected as such clerk, and where such fees do not in any one year amount to the said sum of eight hundred (800) dollars, such clerks shall hereafter receive and retain all fees collected and received by them as such clerks of the court, in lieu of said eight hundred (800) dollars annual salary.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
