fraud, he shall be guilty of forgery in the third degree. and upon conviction thereof, he shall be punished as hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2. If any person utter or publish as true any false. altered, forged or counterfeited certificate, card, seal or receipt issued by any labor organization, trade union or association of mechanics and laboring men, or its officers. or the forging, altering or counterfeiting thereof, as prohibited by the provisions of section I of this act, with intent to deceive or defraud, he shall be guilty of forgery in the third degree, and be punished as hereinafter provided.

SEC. 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Penalty. act, upon conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned in the state prison not more than five years.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 57.

An act authorizing county auditors to distribute taxes Co. Audiin certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. That whenever any county in the state which has been authorized by a special act to levy a two (2) mill tax for school purposes and the same has been repealed, the auditor of said county is hereby authorized and directed to distribute any of said taxes hereafter collected or heretofore collected and not distributed to the school district wherein said tax were levied.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
