CHAPTER 69.

Amendment. 17th Judicial district.

An Act to amend section one (1), chapter ninety-two (92) of the General Laws of 1897, entitled "An act to amend an act entitled 'An act for the establishing of a new judicial district to be known as the seventeenth (17th) judicial district, and to fix dates for holding court therein, approved March 12, 1897."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter ninety-two (92) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred ninety-seven (1897) be and is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Term of court Jackson Co.

"Section I. That section two (2) of an act entitled 'An act for the establishing of a new judicial district to be known as the seventeenth (17th) judicial district, and to fix dates for holding court therein, approved March 12, 1897,' be amended by striking out the fourth line in said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following words: 'In Jackson county, from the first Tuesday in March to the third Monday in May, and from the first Tuesday in October to the third Monday in November of each year.'"

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 70.

Life and casualty insurance. An Act to designate the plan of conducting life and casualty insurance companies, in the State of Minnesota, and to provide penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Designations on policies. Section I. All life and casualty insurance companies, associations or societies doing business in this state, except those associations and fraternal societies having a ritual and operating on the lodge plan, shall have the words "Old Line Assessment Plan, or Stipulated Premium Plan," as the case may be, printed or stamped in bold-face type on the face of all policies, renewal receipts, circulars and applications for policies hereafter to be issued or circulated.
