CHAPTER 396.

Repealing
chapter 415,
special laws
of 1881.

An act repealing an act entitled "an act granting swamp lands to aid in the construction of the main line of railroad of the Little Falls & Dakota Railroad Company."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That an act entitled "an act granting swamp lands to aid in the construction of the main line of railroad of the Little Falls & Dakota Railroad Company," approved March 3, 1881, being chapter four hundred fifteen (415), Special Laws of Minnesota, 1881, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the grant therein made and not already earned is hereby forfeited; *provided, however*, that nothing herein contained shall affect or limit the powers or duties of any officer or officers of this state authorized by any law of this state, or contemplated by any measure now pending before the legislature of this state, which shall hereafter become a law, to settle or adjust any matter now in dispute between the state, or the land commissioner thereof and the Northern Pacific Railway Company, relative to the rights of said Company to lands for the construction of the western twenty seven and seven-tenths (27.7) miles of railroad already constructed on the route prescribed by the said Chapter 415.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 397.

Amendment
of chapter 53,
special laws
of 1891, re-
lating to Du-
luth municipal
court.

An act to amend sections 46 and 47, of chapter fifty-three (53), of the Special Laws of Minnesota, for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one (1891), the same being an act entitled "an act to confirm and continue the present municipal court of the City of Duluth, in the county of St. Louis, in the State of Minnesota; to enlarge the jurisdiction of said court, and to regulate the practice and procedure thereof."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section forty-six (46) of chapter fifty-three (53) of the Special Laws of Minnesota, for the year 1891, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
