

## CHAPTER 31.

S. F. No. 29.

*An act to amend section 7314, General Statutes of 1894, relating to change of venue in criminal cases.* Criminal cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section seven thousand three hundred and fourteen (7314) of the General Statutes of One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-four (1894), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 7314. When the venue has heretofore or shall be hereafter changed to another county in a criminal case, the trial shall be conducted in all respects as if the indictment had been found in the county to which the venue is changed, and all the costs and expenses of the prosecution and trial of the case in such county to which the venue is changed, including officers', witnesses' and jurors' fees, shall be paid by the county in which the offense was committed. Change of venue, expense chargeable to county of origin.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 32.

H. F. No. 20.

*An act to amend chapter two hundred seventy-two (272) of the General Laws of Nineteen Hundred One (1901), relating to public libraries and reading rooms.* Libraries.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section five (5) of chapter two hundred and seventy-two (272) of the General Laws of the year Nineteen Hundred and One (1901) be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 5. The provisions of this act shall not apply to cities having a population of not less than twenty thousand (20,000), and all provisions of law with reference to cities of not less than twenty thousand (20,000) population shall be and remain the same as if this act had not been passed. Cities of 20,000 population.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
