they shall hereafter be grouped and classed with the educational institutes of the state.

SEC. 2. This act shall not be construed to effect the management or administration of said schools or the [tenure] terms of office or powers of the managers and directors thereof, but they shall remain subject to the control now provided by existing laws.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 84.

60th legislative district. An act to amend that subdivision of Section 1000 (2) of Chapter one hundred and twenty (120) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven (1897), entitled "An act to prescribe the bounds of senatorial and representative districts, and to appoint anew the senators and representatives among the several districts," entitled "Sixtieth District."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That that subdivision of section two (2) of chapter one hundred and twenty (120) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven (1897) entitled "Sixtieth District," be amended so as to read as follows:

The sixtieth (60th) district shall be composed of the counties of Wilkin, Clay and Becker, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) senator and three (3) representatives. Representative districts to be divided as follows:

The County of Wilkin shall constitute one representative district, and shall be entitled to elect one representative. The County of Clay shall constitute one representative district, and shall be entitled to elect one representative. The County of Becker shall constitute one representative district, and shall be entitled to elect one representative.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
