amount is hereby appropriated from the revenue fund for that purpose.

CHAPTER 90.

Public Examiner. An act to appropriate money for the contingent expenses of the office of the public examiner.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation. Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of eleven thousand five hundred dollars (\$11,500) out of any money belonging to the State of Minnesota in the hands of the state treasurer not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraving the contingent expenses of the public examiner, including the employes of his department in the performance of the official duties appertaining thereto, for the fiscal years ending July 31st. A. D. 1902, and July 31st. A. D. 1903.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 91.

State treasurer. Stenographer. An act authorizing the state treasurer to employ the services of a stenographer and appropriate money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to employ such stenographic assistance as he may find necessary to facilitate the work in the office of the state treasurer, in an amount not exceeding nine hundred (\$900) dollars annually, payable in monthly installments.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of nine hundred (\$900) dollars annually for the purpose of this act.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
