## CHAPTER 10.

*An act legalizing school bonds heretofore voted upon by cities under the provisions of chapter two hundred and four (204) of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three (1893) and acts amendatory thereof.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Legalizing school bonds heretofore voted, under ch. 204, 1893.

SECTION 1. That all school bonds heretofore voted upon by any city under or pursuant to the provisions of chapter two hundred and four (204) of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota, for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three (1893), as amended by chapter one hundred and twenty-eight (128) of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (1895) and other acts amendatory thereof, are hereby declared to be, when issued and sold, legal and binding obligations of said city; providing that the proposition to issue said bonds received a two-thirds majority of all votes cast upon the proposition to issue said bonds at the election when said proposition was voted upon; and *provided further*, that all other requirements of law have been fully complied with.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 11.

*An act to amend that subdivision of section two (2), of chapter one hundred and twenty (120) of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota, for the year 1897, entitled: "An act to prescribe the bounds of senatorial and representative districts, and to apportion anew the senators and representatives among the several districts," entitled "Thirty-third district."*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
