An act to amend section five thousand six hundred and Oaths and thirty-eight (5638) of the General Statutes of eighteen ments. hundred and ninety-four (1894), relating to oaths and acknowledgments.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section five thousand six hundred and thirty-eight (5638) of the General Statutes eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 5638. The clerks of the circuit and district Clerks of U. CHAPTER 45.

An act to amend section fifty-four (54) of chapter Appropriations three hundred and nine (309) of the General Laws of 1901, relating to appropriations for building bridges, constructing roads or draining lands in certain counties of this state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section fifty-four (54) of chapter three hundred and nine (309) of the General Laws for 1901, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 54. That the sum of two hundred (200) dollars Otter Tail is hereby appropriated out of said fund, to aid in the Perham, building of a bridge across the Otter Tail river, in the \$200. town of Perham, Otter Tail county, Minnesota, at a point where the principal road running east from the village of Perham towards the village of New York Mills,
