Section 35. The certificate of nomination of a candidate selected otherwise than by a convention of delegates shall be signed only after the holding of the regular primary election by electors resident within the district or political division from which the candidate is presented, as follows:

If for a state office on a state ticket equal to one per cent (I per cent) of the entire vote of the state cast at the last preceding general election; if for a congressional or judicial district office, by five per cent (5 per cent) of the entire vote cast in any such district at the last preceding general election; and if for a county, legislative or municipal office, by ten per cent (10 per cent) of the entire vote cast in any such county, city, village, ward or other election district at the last preceding general election.

*Provided*, that the number of signatures required shall not exceed two thousand (2,000) for any state office, nor five hundred (500) for any congressional or judicial district, nor for any other office.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 135.

An act relating to the revolving fund at the state prison.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. The board of control and the warden of Revolving the state prison are authorized, whenever in their judgment it becomes necessary in order to meet the current demands on the revolving fund of the state prison, to borrow such sums of money as may be necessary. Such sums so borrowed, however, shall not exceed in any one year one-half of the total of the revolving fund of said prison.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
