PASSED AND APPROVED DURING THE THIRTY-FIFTH SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE COMMENCING JANUARY EIGHTH, 1907.

CHAPTER 1-S. F. No. 1.

An Act to appropriate money for the expenses of the present session of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

\$150,000 for legislative expense.—Section 1. That the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand (150,000) dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of the per diem, mileage and other expenses of the members and officers of the legislature during the present session thereof.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
