CHAPTER 146-S, F. No. 254.

An Act for the establishment of a new judicial district to be known as the Nineteenth judicial district, and to fix dates for holding terms of court therein.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Nineteenth judicial district established.—Section 1. That the counties of Kanabec, Pine, Chisago and Washington are hereby detached from the First judicial district, and said counties so detached are hereby created into a judicial district to be known and designated as the Nineteenth judicial district of Minnesota.

Terms of court—when held—special terms provided for.
—Sec. 2. The terms of court in said new district shall be held as follows:

In Kanabec county, on the third Tuesday in March of each year.

In Chisago county, on the first Wednesday in October in each year.

In Pine county, on the second Tuesday in April and the third Tuesday in September of each year.

In the county of Washington, on the first Tuesday in May and the third Tuesday in November of each year.

And in addition to the general terms of said court in said Washington county, special terms of said court shall be held in said county on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month for the trial of issues of fact by the court without a jury, for the trial of issues of law, the hearing of motions, applications and all matters except the trial of issues of fact by a jury.

Governor to appoint.—Sec. 3. A district judge shall be elected for said district at the next general election, and the governor is hereby authorized to appoint a district judge for said district to serve until his successor shall be elected and qualified.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
