

CHAPTER 241—H. F. No. 1196.

An Act entitled an act to provide for fixing the salary of the first assistant commissioner of public works in all cities in this state now or hereafter having population of over 50,000 inhabitants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Salary of first assistant commissioner of public works \$3,600.—Section 1. That in all cities of this state now or hereafter having a population of over 50,000 inhabitants, the commissioner of public works of any such city is hereby authorized and empowered to fix and prescribe the salary and compensation of the first assistant commissioner of public works of such city at an amount not to exceed three thousand six hundred (\$3,600) dollars per annum and the sum so fixed and determined shall be paid to such officer in equal monthly installments from the treasury of such city.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 242—S. F. No. 907.

An Act relating to salaries of court reporters in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Filing of order.—Section 1. That whenever a new judicial district is created, or the boundary lines of a judicial district is changed, the judge or judges of such district or districts shall, within thirty (30) days after the establishing of such new district or the changing of such boundary lines, file an order readjusting the salaries of court reporters and the proportions to be paid by the several counties, with the several county auditors in each district, to conform to such changes, and the filing of such order shall vacate and set aside any and all orders then on file with such auditors.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
