ance, any rebate of premium payable on the policy, or any special feature or advantage in the dividends or other benefits to accrue thereon or any paid employment or contract for services of any kind or any valuable consideration or inducement whatever not specified in the policy contract of insurance.

Violation a misdemeanor.—Sec. 2. Any violations of the provisions of section 1 of this act shall be a misdemeanor and punishable as such.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after Jan. 1, 1908.

An Act to fix the hours during which the polls shall be open for the holding of school elections in certain independent school districts in the State of Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Polls to be open from 6 a. m. to 7 p. m.—Section 1. In all independent school districts in this state containing a population of fifty thousand (50,000) inhabitants or over, to be based upon the census last preceding the election, and in which independent school districts elections are held exclusively for school purposes, and separate from, and at different dates from city and state elections, the polls at such school elections shall be opened at six (6) o'clock a. m. on the day of such election, and shall remain open for purposes of voting until seven o'clock p. m. on said day.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
