

Visitors committee.—Sec. 4. The executive board of the Minnesota state horticultural society is hereby required to appoint a committee of two suitable persons to visit said fruit breeding farm, at least once in each year, to examine the fruit breeding work being done there, and to report on the progress of such work to the Minnesota state horticultural society and board of regents of the state university, together with such recommendations for the future conduct of said farm as may seem to them best.

This act shall take effect and be in force on and after its passage.

CHAPTER 335—S. F. No. 297.

An Act to amend section 3453 Revised Laws 1905, relating to the area of homestead exemptions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Homestead exemptions.—Section 1. That section 3453, Revised Laws, 1905, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“Section 3453. Such homestead may include any quantity of land not exceeding eighty acres, and not included in the laid out or platted portion of any incorporated city, village or borough. If it be within the laid out or platted portion of such incorporated place having five thousand inhabitants or over, its area shall not exceed one-third of an acre, and if it be within the laid out or platted portion of such incorporated place containing fewer than five thousand inhabitants, the area so exempted shall not exceed one-half of an acre.”

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
