CHAPTER 43—S. F. No. 166.

An Act to prohibit misrepresentations by life insurance companies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Prohibiting circulation of false statements.—Section 1. No life insurance company doing business in this state, and no officer, director or agent thereof shall issue or circulate, or cause or permit to be issued or circulated, any estimate, illustration, circular or statement of any sort misrepresenting the terms of any policy issued by it or the benefits or advantages promised thereby, or the dividends or shares of surplus to be received thereon, or shall use any name or title of any policy or class of policies misrepresenting the true nature thereof.

Misdemeanor for doing same.—Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and the license of any company which shall authorize or permit a violation of this act shall be revoked.

Sec. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 44—H. F. No. 240.

An Act relating to the provisions of life insurance policies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Policies to contain entire contract between parties.—Section 1. Every policy of insurance issued or delivered within this state on or after the first day of January, nineteen hun-

dred and eight, by any life insurance corporation doing business within the state shall contain the entire contract between the parties.

Sec. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 45—H. F. No. 269.

An Act to prevent the killing of wild animals or birds upon the Minnesota state forest reserve lands and parks:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Killing of wild animals or birds prohibited on forest reserve.—Section 1. No person shall kill, or pursue with intent to kill, take, snare, or have in possession by any means upon the Minnesota state forest reserve lands or parks any wild animals or birds; *provided* that this act shall not prohibit the state forestry board from destroying wolves or other noxious animals thereon. The killing of each such animal or bird shall constitute a separate offense.

Misdemeanor—penalty prescribed.—Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty (\$50) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100) dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty (30) days or more than ninety (90) days or both.

Sec. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
