

shall not be construed as modifying any of the provisions of sections 5515 and 5516, Revised Laws, 1905, except as herein provided, and any newspaper in order to be qualified as a legal newspaper, subsequent to the making of such affidavit, shall in all respects comply with the provisions of sections 5515 and 5516, Revised Laws, 1905. The provisions of this act shall not apply to any action or proceeding now pending in any of the courts in this state.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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#### CHAPTER 464—H. F. No. 1209.

*An Act to provide for a levy of taxes for state purposes for the year ending July 31st, 1908, and July 31st, 1909.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

**Tax levy.**—Section 1. For the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state for the fiscal year ending July 31st, 1908, a tax of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000), or as near that amount as practicable, shall be levied on all the taxable property of the state; *provided*, that the tax hereby levied shall not exceed the rate of one and seven-tenths mills on each dollar of taxable property.

**Amount.**—Sec. 2. For the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state for the fiscal year ending July 31st, 1909, a tax of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000), or as near that amount as practicable, shall be levied on all taxable property of the state; *provided*, that the tax hereby levied shall not exceed the rate of one and seven-tenths mills on each dollar of taxable property.

**Fund.**—Sec. 3. All taxes levied under the provisions of this act, when collected and paid into the state treasury, shall be placed to the credit of the general revenue fund only.
