

CHAPTER 68—H. F. No. 317.

An Act to authorize the board of control of any county to fix the salary of the secretary appointed by it.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Salary of secretary of county board of control.—Section 1. The board of control of any county in this state is authorized to fix the salary of the secretary appointed by it, at such sum as the board may deem proper, not exceeding \$2,000 per annum, payable monthly, out of the funds appropriated on account of salaries, or otherwise for the maintenance of the board.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 69—H. F. No. 161.

An Act to amend section ninety-four (94) of chapter three hundred and thirty-eight (338) of the General Laws of one thousand nine hundred and five (1905), appropriating money out of the internal improvement fund to aid in building bridges and constructing and draining roads in certain townships, villages and counties in this state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Extension of road and bridge appropriations.—Section 1. That section ninety-four (94) of chapter three hundred and thirty-eight (338) of the General Laws for the year one thousand nine hundred and five (1905), be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 94. All appropriations in aid of building roads, bridges or other road improvements made under the provisions of chapter 309, Laws of 1901, chapter 79, Laws of 1902, and chapter 290, Laws of 1903, and which have not heretofore been expended, and which have not heretofore or are not by this act expressly repealed, are hereby extended and are hereby made available until December 31, 1909, and none of the provisions of the Revised Laws of 1905 shall be construed as repealing any of said appropriations.
