appropriate observance of Memorial Day on the 30th day of May of each year and in the annual commemoration of the noble and valiant deeds of the nation's soldier dead.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 366-H. F. No. 841.

An Act relating to the surrey of registered lands by county surveyors in all counties of the state having more than two hundred thousand inhabitants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

County surveyor authorized to survey registered lands on request of registrar of titles.—Section 1. In any county of this state having more than two hundred thousand inhabitants, the county surveyor thereof shall, at the request of the examiner of titles for such county, make a survey of the plat described in any application for registration under chapter 65, Revised Laws Minnesota, 1905, and file with the clerk of the district court of such county a plat of such land, duly certified, showing the dimensions of the land, the location of all structures, fences and other improvements thereon and such other facts as may be required by the examiner.

The surveyor shall also at the request of the registrar of titles of such county, make a survey of any registered land designated by him and file with such registrar a plat of such land, duly certified showing its dimensions and such other facts as the registrar may require.

Such plat shall be numbered and entered as a memorial on the original owner's duplicate certificate of such land and transferred with each subsequent certificate affecting such land.

In any county in which the county surveyor receives fees in lieu of a salary, he shall be paid such compensation for his services as the county board may determine; in all other counties, he shall receive no other compensation than the salary paid him for other county work.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. Approved April 22, 1909.
