CHAPTER 171-S. F. No. 457.

An act to amend section 1 of chapter 45 of the General Laws of 1907, to prevent the killing of wild animals or birds upon the Minnesota State Forest Reserve Lands and parks and within national forests.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Taking or killing of game on national forest lands prohibited.-Section 1. That section 1, chapter 45 of the General Laws of 1907 be amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. No person shall kill, or pursue with intent to kill, take, snare, or have in possession, by any means, upon the Minnesota state forest reserve lands or parks, national forest lands, or upon any lands that may be designated by the state game and fish commission as game propagating and breeding grounds, any wild-animals or birds protected at any time by law. The killing or having in possession of each such protected animal or bird shall constitute a separate offense.

"Provided, that this act shall not prohibit the killing or destroying of wolves or other noxious animals by or under the supervision of the state game and fish commission or the state forestry board."

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 172-H. F. No. 397.

An Act relative to the construction of laws regulating the affairs of cities of the first class.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Act regulating cities of the first class not applicable to any city unless expressly declared.-Section 1. No act regulating any of the affairs of cities, of the first class, shall be deemed applicable to any city therein existing under a charter framed and adopted under section 36 of article 4 of the state constitution, authorizing the adoption by cities of charters for their own government, unless the intention to make the same so applicable shall by such act be expressly declared.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
