

CHAPTER 25—S. F. No. 348.

An Act repealing chapter CCIX (209), Special Laws 1872. "An act limiting and regulating the salaries of the county auditor and treasurer of the County of Dodge."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Repealing special law relating to salaries of auditor and treasurer of Dodge county.—Section 1. That chapter CCIX (209), Special Laws of the regular session of 1872, be, and the same is hereby, repealed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 26—H. F. No. 88.

An Act to amend section one (1) of chapter 99, General Laws of 1907, relating to appropriation of money by counties to be used for the purpose of maintaining an exhibit at the State Fair.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

County commissioners empowered to appropriate \$500 for county exhibits at state fair.—Section 1. That section 1, of chapter 99, General Laws of 1907, be, and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The board of county commissioners of any county in the state is hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate out of the general revenue fund of said county, such a sum of money, not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) annually, as they may deem advisable for the purpose of assisting to maintain an exhibit of the products of said county at the Minnesota state fair.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
