court, whose duties shall be designated by said clerk and who shall be paid the following salaries: One deputy clerk, who shall be paid a salary of eighteen hundred (1800) dollars per annum: one deputy clerk, who shall be paid a salary of fifteen hundred (1500) dollars per annum; one deputy clerk, who shall be paid a salary of thirteen hundred (1300) dollars per annum; four deputy clerks, who shall each be paid a salary of twelve hundred (1200) dollars per annum; eight deputy clerks, who shall each be paid a salary of one thousand (1000) dollars per annum.

Salaries; how paid.—Sec. 2. The above salaries shall be paid monthly in the same manner as county officials are now paid, and the same shall be in full compensation for all services rendered by said deputy clerks in their capacity.

Sec. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 34-H. F. No. 260.

An Act to amend section 7 of chapter 405 of the Laws of 1907, relating to bridge appropriation to Blue Earth County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Changing appropriation for bridge in Blue Earth county.— Section 1. That section 7 of chapter 405 of the Laws of 1907, relating to the construction of a bridge in Blue Earth county, be amended to read as follows:

(7) Blue Earth county.

(a) To be available for the fiscal year ending July 31st, 1908, \$3,000.00 to aid in the building of a bridge across the Minnesota river on or near the section line between sections 13 and 14, township 108 of range 27 west, in the city of Mankato, Blue Earth county, and on or near the section line between sections 11 and 12, in the township of Belgrade in Nicollet county, the exact location to be determined by the city engineer of the city of Mankato and the county surveyor of Blue Earth county.

(b) To be available for the fiscal year ending July 31st, 1909, \$3,000.00 for the same purpose.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
