CHAPTER 222-S. F. No. 334.

An Act to amend section 3554 Revised Laws of Minnesota for 1905, relating to prohibited marriages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Marriage of second cousins prohibited.—Section 1. That section 3554 Revised Laws of 1905 be and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

Section 3554. No marriage shall be contracted while either of the parties has a husband or wife living; nor within six months after either has been divorced from a former spouse; nor between parties who are nearer of kin than second cousins, whether of the half or whole blood, computed by the rules of the civil law; nor between persons either one of whom is epileptic, imbecile, feeble minded or insane.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1911.

An Act to amend section 834 Revised Laws 1905, relating to listing personal property for taxation in case of doubt.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Tax commission to determine proper place of listing personal property.—Section 1. That section 834 Revised Laws, 1905 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

834. Where listed in case of doubt.—In case of doubt as to the proper place of listing personal property or where it cannot be listed as in this chapter provided, if between places in the same county, the place for listing and assessing shall be determined by the county board of equalization; and if between different counties, or places in different counties, by the Minnesota tax commission; and when determined in either case shall be as binding as if fixed hereby.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
