CHAPTER 1-H. F. No. 5.

An Act to appropriate money for the payment of the salary of the licutenant governor and the salary and the mileage of the members of the legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and the employees of and all the other expenses of the legislature—including payment for necessary supplies therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation of \$125,000 for legislative expenses.—That the sum of one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000.00) or so much thereof as may be found necessary be and the same hereby is appropriated from the revenue fund for the payment of the salary of the lieutenant governor and the salary and the mileage of the members of the legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and the employees of and all the other expenses of the legislature—including payment for necessary supplies therefor.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 2—H. F. 110.

An Act' to authorize and empower cities in the State of Minnesota which now have or hereafter may have 20,000, and not more than 50,000, inhabitants to reconstruct, rebuild, pave, repair and improve certain bridges and to issue bonds therefor.
