

CHAPTER 18—H. F. No. 95.

An Act to prohibit the sale or advertising for sale of cold storage eggs without making it known to the purchaser or prospective purchaser that they are cold storage eggs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Cold storage eggs to be labelled.—No person, firm or corporation by himself or his agents shall sell, agree to sell, or advertise for sale any cold storage eggs without making it known to the purchaser or prospective purchaser that the eggs are cold storage eggs, and all boxes or other receptacles in which cold storage eggs are sold or delivered, in wholesale or retail, shall be stamaped in a conspicuous manner with the words: "Cold Storage Eggs."

Sec. 2. Dairy and food commissioner to enforce provisions.—The dairy and food commissioner of the state is charged with the proper enforcement of all the provisions of this act.

Sec. 3. Violation a misdemeanor.—Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than fifteen days for each and every offense.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 19—H. F. No. 155.

An Act appropriating the sum of two thousand dollars to be used in defraying the immediate and necessary expenses of the state drainage board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. \$2,000 appropriated for immediate use of drainage commission.—That the sum of two thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be required, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to defray the immediate and necessary expenses of the state drainage board.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
