CHAPTER 147-S. F. No. 803.

An act to reimburse the official reporter of the district court of the sixth judicial district for amounts paid out for railway, traveling and hotel expenses while in the discharge of his official duties.

Be it exacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. 6th judicial district court reporters allowed traveling expenses while absent from residence on official duty.—The official reporter of the district court of the sixth judicial district of the state shall be paid, in addition to the amounts now provided by law, all sums he shall hereafter pay out for necessary railway, traveling and hotel expenses within said district, while in the discharge of his official duties.

Such expenses shall be paid by the respective counties for which the same were incurred, upon presentation of a verified and itemized statement of the reporter therefor, duly approved by the judge of said court, to the county auditor, whereupon the auditor shall issue his warrant in payment thereof.

CHAPTER 148-S. F. No. 731.

An act to reimburse official reporters of the district court of the eighth judicial district for amounts paid out for railway, traveling and hotel expenses while absent from their places of residence in the discharge of their official duties. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Bth judicial district court reporters allowed traveling expenses while absent from residence on official duty.—The official reporters of the district court of the eighth judicial district of the state shall be paid, in addition to the amounts now provided by law, all sums they shall hereafter pay out as necessary railway, traveling and hotel expenses while absent from their places of residence in the discharge of their official duties.

Such expenses shall be paid by the respective counties for which the same were incurred, upon presentation of a verified and itemized statement of the reporter therefor, duly approved by the judge of said court, to the county auditor, whereupon the auditor shall issue his warrant in payment thereof.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
